APPLICATION INFORMATION

The Virginia Aviation Foundation, Inc. scholarships are available to high school students in the Commonwealth of Virginia who plan to attend an accredited school or academy to pursue an aviation-related career.

Criteria for Application:

- The student must be a high school senior enrolled in a Virginia school district.
- The student must have applied to a school or academy with an accredited aviation-related program. *Students must be accepted to the accredited program before scholarship award is made.*
- The student must have a minimum of a 2.8 GPA (based on a 4.0 system).
- The student must return the application and required attachments by **March 1, 2009** to the Virginia Aviation Foundation, Inc.

This scholarship is not need based. Representatives from the Virginia Aviation Foundation will review application packages and, at their sole discretion, select up to two qualified recipients.

The student's acceptance letter must be provided to the Virginia Aviation Foundation, Inc. in order for the scholarship check to be awarded.
